Offering a rare 4-seat plus wheelchair or mobility scooter configuration, this LWB model provides an excellent balance of passenger space and accessibility. Unlike many long wheelbase WAVs that retain 5 seats but compromise wheelchair room, this layout prioritises usable internal space, making it ideal for larger wheelchairs and mobility scooters.

With just 5,924 miles, full service history, and a high specification Allure trim, this is a standout example.

Is this a rare layout for a Peugeot Rifter WAV? Yes the 4 seats plus wheelchair configuration is much less common, especially in a long wheelbase model. Most LWB Rifiers are 5-seat conversions, which can limit wheelchair space.

Can it take a large mobility scooter? Yes, this is one of its key strengths. The LWB design combined with the 4-seat layout provides more usable space, making it suitable for many larger mobility scooters. We always recommend checking measurements before purchase.

What is the benefit of a fold-flat ramp? A fold-flat ramp stores neatly inside the vehicle when not in use, improving rear visibility and making everyday driving easier compared to upright ramps. It also keeps the rear area more practical when the wheelchair space isn't needed.

Why choose a 4-seat LWB over a 5-seat version? A 5-seat LWB often reduces the available wheelchair area. This 4-seat configuration gives you more practical space where it matters, especially for larger chairs or scooters.
